

A Diocesan Intercession List for 2010

The Episcopal Diocese of Western Louisiana

Reflecting upon the Catechism, we are reminded ... “the Church is described as the Body of which Jesus Christ is the Head and all baptized persons are the members.” Scripture reminds us again and again that we are members of one body, interrelated to all the other members through our mutual beliefs and prayers. We believe that the action of any one part of the body affects all the other parts, for good or ill.

Remembering all this, and our Lord's injunctions that we care for one another, we offer for the use of the people of God in this Diocese of Western Louisiana a calendar of intercessions to be used daily in a thirty or thirty-one day cycle.

There are several ways in which this calendar can be integrated into the daily prayers both of churches and individuals; below we offer three in the hope that one will be useful to all who read these words.

First, the intercessions may be used within the Daily Offices of Morning or Evening Prayer as appointed in the Prayer Book. They are most appropriately inserted after the collect for mission in each Office, where the rubrics permit "authorized intercessions."

Secondly, the calendar may be used in the shorter Offices called "Daily Devotions for Individuals and Families" found on Page 136-140 in the Prayer Book. The Intercessions may be inserted immediately before the Lord's Prayer.

Thirdly, the Intercessions may be offered individually in times of private devotion. We suggest the following three prayers, plus the Lord's Prayer, as appropriate vehicles to our common intercessions.
